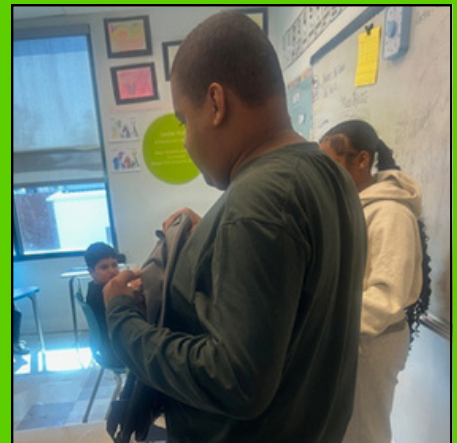


LIFE BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

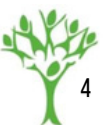

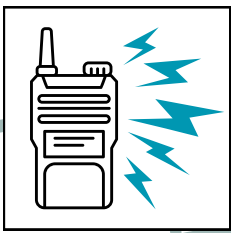
Back on campus, students continued developing responsibility and daily living skills by caring for their therapeutic fish, reinforcing consistency, attention to detail, and pride in ownership.

Together, these experiences reflect a strong commitment to preparing students for life beyond the classroom.

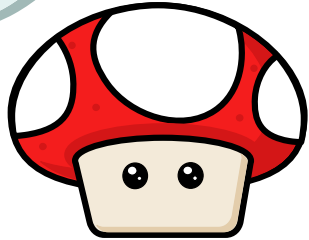
