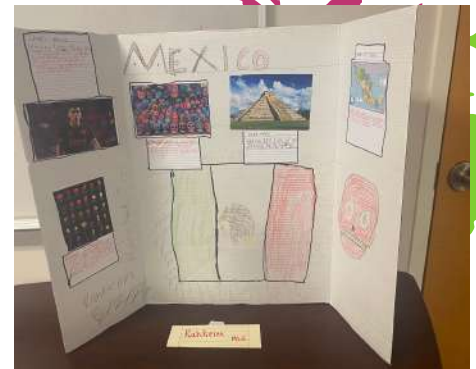

Students have worked hard to strengthen skills related to emotional regulation, problem-solving, communication, coping strategies, self-advocacy, and building positive peer relationships. We are proud of the resilience and progress they have demonstrated both inside and outside of the classroom.



As summer begins, transitions in routine can sometimes be exciting while also presenting challenges for children and adolescents. 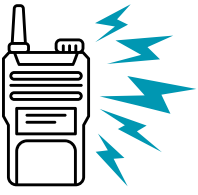

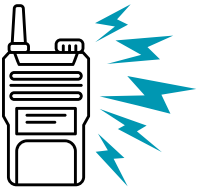

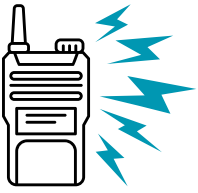
